The Pastor's Pen

Our 2025 Stewardship Campaign has begun!

Officially, we kicked-off next year's campaign on Sunday, 7 April 2024, when the Finance & Stewardship Committee determined it is important that we learn lessons from previous years and implement them in proactive and productive ways as we journey through this year and prepare for our future in ministry to God and for God's people in Statesville. Already, those of you attending church and reading recent Orders for Worship have seen that we are including what financial information we can to further our culture of transparency. Across the next months, you will receive sermons and letters that will deepen our campaign and program, all in hopes of showing you how your stewardship helps us to flourish for God and neighbor.

While this is not the typical "Pastor's Pen" that you might be accustomed to reading from me, it is one I am happy to write for myriad reasons and give

insight about some decisions that have been made in the recent weeks and months at the church. Before I begin with these decisions, I hope you'll allow me to explain why we are connecting with you this way.

We have found that effective communication is probably the most difficult function of our habitual tasks at the church. Because we serve you—people of different generations and varying preferences—it is not easy to know the best way to share the same information across the span of our congregation's family and friends. Some prefer email and like getting weekly Wednesday Words that way; others enjoy being able to go online to the church website to locate this same weekly update as well as the monthly newsletter. Still, there are some who pine to hold a physical document in hand; while certain members wish we still had the weekly phone call through OneCallNow. And of course, not everyone comes to church worship the same week to get the Order for Worship and hear

the same information. The difficulty is that there is no "one" method to convey the same information to everyone, so this newsletter edition must serve as the way we can say, "Remember May 2024; that's where you'll find it."

Stewardship is often regarded as the least fun season in the church because so many people believe it deals almost exclusively with money. In many respects, this can feel true; however, if you have listened to the sermons since October of last year, we have tried to make **Tithes** only 20% of what our FPC Stewardship looks like. Tithing is just one point of a five-pointed star, sharing the spotlight with Time, Talents, Treasures, and Traditions.

In our church (as with any agency), we need money to make things happen. Just as we were ramping up to begin our big push for the Centennial Capital Campaign, our Session recognized the need we have

to fund and hire a new Associate Pastor for Christian Formation (the new way of speaking about Education). Such a step out in faith will require of us another \$70,000-\$75,000 in annual revenue and expenditure, with hope that this individual might add to the leadership and increase in our congregation. Because of this, the hard months of work and planning for the Sanctuary's renovation have been paused indefinitely, until we can return to it in time. We will continue to take care of one of our greatest **Treasures**—the Sanctuary—along with the grounds, the McGeachy Building, and the Manse through the means we can as we must and are able. But for now, our Stewardship commitment has shifted to help us to raise money to have another person called to this growing congregation for our Children, Youth, and Adult formation and education programs. And we need you.

The work of the church ought never to fall into the 20-80 rule—where 20% of the people do 80% of the work. Such a model is not sustainable, and it will quickly lead to the burnout many are feeling. So, Stewardship & Finance wants us also to consider the ways by which each of us has at least one way we can share our **Time & Talents** for the good of others. As I wrote in January of this year, just imagine if each active member joined just one committee in its work and witness. If each of the 248 of us (as of 15 April 2024 and regardless of age) was able to contribute to some committee in some way, few of us would feel the pulls of church work, and all of us would benefit from each other's wisdom, experience, and contribution. To this end, you will find a newly prepared Time & Talents Survey has been developed that we hope you will complete and return to the church to become a means by which we can better employ you in God's service and for others in our congregation and community. I hope we might turn the 20-80 rule on its head, where we have at least 80% of our active members all sharing so that none of us

must do more than 20% of the work at a time.... So, we need you.

And finally, the growth of our church is not unprecedented; this congregation has grown rapidly before in generations before this one. But for us who are called to this home for now, the growth seems staggering and somewhat daunting. I promise you that an Associate Pastor or even a Parish Associate will not solve our problems—that is not their calling. This person will join a team made of two phenomenal Directors of Music Ministries and Preschool, a qualified Financial Secretary, a most hospitable Office Manager and Administrative Assistant, and your Pastor. But they will also join you to do work, service, missions, and ministry to help this congregation recognize the **Traditions** that we can be proud of as we plan for upcoming ministries about which we haven't yet dreamed. Yes; we need you.

The Stewardship & Finance Committee, your Session, and the FPC Office Team are excited to see how we all respond to God's summons and our request for your participation across the next eight months of this year and beyond. We aren't looking just to make a good budget that lives "in the black," but we want to create a true lifestyle being the Watered Garden, where we Tend the Fig Tree, and Offer Ourselves with Generosity (former Stewardship Campaign titles). In such a way, we honor the commitments of the generations before us while building on the foundation for those who will come after us.

We need you.

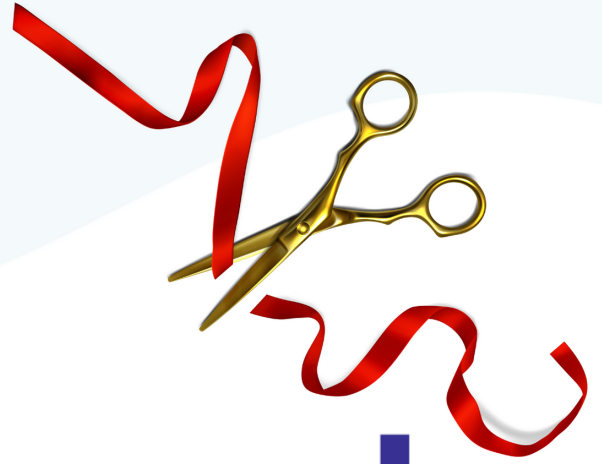

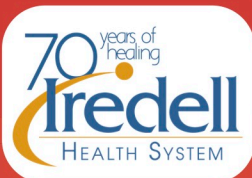
