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▪ **First Presbyterian Church Annual Missions Grant Application**

The mission of the First Presbyterian Church's Annual Missions Grant is to enhance and strengthen our community by offering a grant up to \$10,000 for eligible organizations.

Eligibility and Funding:

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations in North Carolina connected to and serving the residents of Iredell County.
- Eligible funding areas include any project that will enhance the ability to serve an organization's clients and our community. Funding for general operating costs will *not* be considered.
- Grants are one year in duration, and organizations may submit one application per grant cycle. Organizations who are awarded funding must wait one year between award cycles before reapplying.
- All grant recipients will be asked to provide an evaluation report: Community/individuals served, accounting for grant expenses, and project outcome (if applicable). If a complete evaluation report is not received, an organization may be ineligible for future funding.

Grant Cycle:

- Applications open **1 October** and will close on **31 October** each calendar year.
- Recipient(s) will be announced in November, and the award will be made at the first of the year.

- Current budget - income statement
- Board of Directors
- Current impact report
